Accompanied by an experienced mentor, you will learn various operational skills (driving, resource management ...) in passenger transport.

This period will be punctuated by trainings tailored to our business (transport systems, production engineering, management, law and social relationships, finance...) which are provided by the Keolis University in partnership with SNCF (French National Railway Company).

After this training period, you will have been exposed to all of the components of Guided Modes Operations: Production, Methods, Planning, Management etc., and you will then be appointed to an operational position in one of our guided modes (tram – metro – railway) subsidiaries abroad.
